The corresponding delivery costs are charged to the author services.

The new website offers **full transparency** on what you can order and why, depending on **available stocks** and your **remaining quotas**.

For each publication in a bulk order catalogue, the website shows the number of copies per logistical unit (box, tube or other).

Ideally, you should **try to order by box**, as it saves time and money if you do so, rather than count and pick a random number of copies.

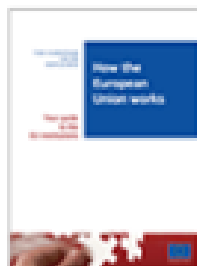



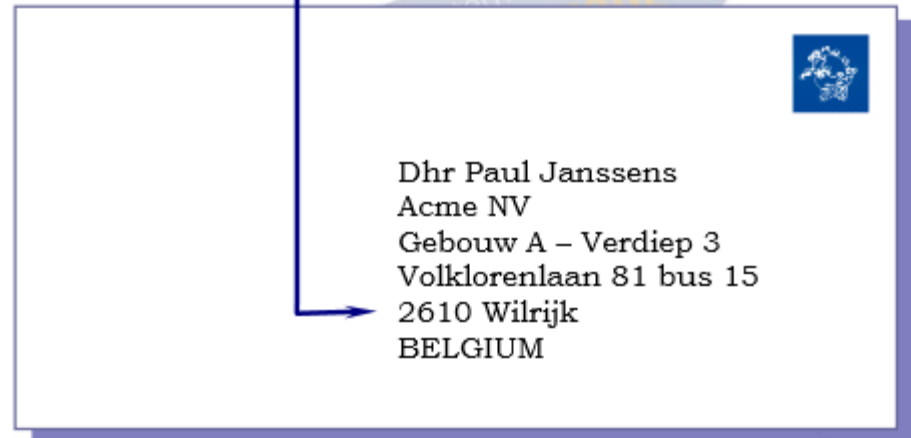
