#### **PRACTICAL INFORMATION**

#### 1. Travel Arrangements

- Carlson Wagonlit Travel (Ms Monique Flameng) from Brussels will contact you to settle the timetables and tickets for your travel, as well as your hotel accommodation.
- The travel expenses from your city to Bruges by airplane and/or train will be covered by the Commission, using the applicable travel rule of most economic tariff.
- The local travel expenses between your home/office and the airport or railway station will
  not be reimbursed, neither those between the railway station and your hotel in Bruges.
  Should you decide to buy your tickets yourself, please bear in mind that you will not be
  reimbursed.
- Should you decide to use your own car for the travel, this will be done at your own expense.

#### 2. Transportation to and in Bruges

 Please refer to the attached information sheet 'Access by transport from Brussels' for detailed instructions on how to reach Bruges upon your arrival in Belgium. For your reference, please also find attached a map of Bruges.

#### 3. Accommodation

#### **ACCESS BY TRANSPORT FROM BRUSSELS**

#### By train

Upon arrival at Brussels National Airport (Zaventem, BRU), take the train to the city centre from the airport's railway station (at basement level -1). You will then have to change trains at any of the three Brussels railway stations (Nord/Noord, Central/Centraal or Midi/Zuid). Trains with destination Oostende or Knokke/Blankenberge (all stopping in Bruges) leave from any of the Brussels stations every +/- 30 minutes. The train ride takes about 20 minutes from the airport to Brussels and about 60 minutes from Brussels to Bruges.

#### **Directions to the hotels**

At the Bruges railway station (exit Bruges Centrum) you can take a taxi €9\* (+/-), a bus (ticket: €1,70\*) or walk to your hotel. Please see the map of Bruges in attachment.

On foot: 7 minutes (+/-)

Bus 1, 3, 4, 6, 11, 13, 14, 16 or 23: get off at 't Zand (first stop)

Martin's Hotel - Oude Burg 5 - tel. 050 44 51 11

On foot: 20-25 minutes (+/-)

Bus 1: get off at the Belfry on Wollestraat (third stop)

#### Directions to the STS venue - Verversdijk

At the Bruges railway station (exit Bruges Centrum) you can take a taxi €10\* (+/-), a bus or walk to Verversdijk. Please see the map of Bruges in attachment.

College of Europe, Verversdijk Extension – Verversdijk 16

On foot: 30 minutes (+/-)

**Bus 14**: get off at <u>Koningsbrug</u> (fifth stop), cross the bridge and turn left along the canal (Spinolarei). At the end of the street, turn right onto Verversdijk and continue until you reach the College of Europe building on the right-hand side.
