


## Have Your Say Portal

- The Portal is part of the new ecosystem of democratic citizen engagement.
- Its launch follows citizens' proposals in the Communication released after COFE.
- One of three gateways of the revamped Have Your Say portal:
  - Public Consultations and Feedback
  - European Citizens' Initiative (ECI)
  - Citizens' Engagement Platform (CEP)



## The European Citizens' Panels

- Democratic innovation: reinforce representative democracy
- Deliberative format: citizens work on common solutions.
  - 150 randomly selected citizens representative of EU diversity for 3 weekends on topics of EU importance.
  - Topics of Food Waste, Learning Mobility, Virtual Worlds,
     Energy Efficiency and Tackling Hatred in Society.
- Panels contribute to the first stages of EU policy-making: policy initiative adopted with a Citizens' Report.
- Connecting with the local level





## The Citizens' Engagement Platform

A digital platform for citizens and hub for connecting different levels of participation



Allow all citizens to share their ideas and exchange on them Reporting from events

Online tool to **support** participatory and deliberative processes.



Shows multilingual content and enables interaction in the 24 official EU languages.

### **ECIs - Impact**

- Access to clean drinking water is protected in the EU
- More transparent authorisations for food-related products such as pesticides, additives or packaging materials
- Protect and strengthen the cosmetics animal testing ban and support of the development of alternative scientific approaches
- Impact assessment on the environmental, social and economic consequences of applying the "fins naturally attached" policy (for sharks)
- Sparking policy debate
- Organisers expand their network and build communication, negotiation, advocacy skills



#### At a glance: Welcome to the European Citizens' Initiative (ECI) handbook

The European Citizens' initiative (ECI) is a unique participatory democracy tool that allows EU citizens from different Member States to call on the European Commission (EC) to propose legislative changes on issues that matter to them.

Taking part in European democracy is every EU citizen's right. EU citizens can sign European citizens' initiatives or start one of their own.

To launch a citizens' initiative takes at least 7 EU citizens, living in 7 different Member States, who are old enough to vote in the European elections.

They choose a topic that they care about, from any field where the European Commission has power to propose legislation and submit a proposal. The Commission checks the legal admissibility of the idea and decides whether to register the initiative.

If registered, the initiative is posted on the ECI website, translated into all EU languages, and the organisers can start collecting signatures. They have one year to author 1 million verified signatures – demonstrating that other Europeans also care about the idea. If prough signatures are collected, the
