PEWG on Electronic Repositories

Bocconi

Launched in Spring 2010 (call for proposal) to **stimulate co-operation** and pool members' expertise for the benefit of the EDC Network and **to revitalise our Network** within restricted resources (especially staff and time)

November 2010 - 1st meeting in Brussels: after survey and selection of repositories, working plan for 2011 and creation of 2 sub-groups

November 2011- 2nd meeting during AGM in Malta: **evolution of ESO in a Pan-European EDCs project**; next step: training and pilot project with a group of 12-25 EDCs from different countries

International cooperation Our reactions to the evolution of ESO

Promotion and debate at a national level: sharing information, web page about the project, brainstorming...

Interest for the project: highest number of participants from Italy (25% of feedback)

Questions about the next stage of the project (training, information sources, details about the contribution asked to the Italian EDCs ...)

Request of the Italian member **to participate** in the trial project **in representation of the network as a whole**: free subscription for all, possibility to train other EDCs in Italy after the training in Cardiff, Italian contribution managed at a national level

European Documentation Centre (EDC)

The European Documentation Centre (EDC) of the Library was established in 1983 based on an agreement between Bocconi University and European Commission. It is part of a network which includes 600 centres across the world, mostly in universities, research centres and national libraries, with 400 of them in the Member States and 51 in Italy.

The EDC provides access to the European information for the University Community and general public, and offers:

- information and bibliography reference services
- access to the official EU databases
- books and journals (for consultation only)
- free booklets on European policies

The Bocconi EDC is member of the Editor's Group of **wikicde**, the wiki guide of the Italian EDCs, and of **cdeita**, the national website of the Italian EDCs network.

Conclusions

- 1) EDC is part of the **host institution** (in our case the University Library):
 - Support from the host structure is fundamental
- 2) Main and usual EDC **users** are students, professors, researchers:
 - Cooperation with the **Faculty** is very important
 - Scientific and specialized publications are needed
- 3) EDC staff members are **EU Information specialists** with a long experience on finding the EU information and documents:
 - Main role of EDC as centre of guidance on how to find and use EU information

Conclusions



4) Nowaday EDCs are part of the Europe Direct Network:

- EDC can promote events open to the general public in cooperation with other networks (in our case EDC as coordinator of other networks in the University)
- 5) Usually EDC has restricted resources (staff, time, funding):
 - Co-operation, sharing best-practices among EDCs and support from the Representation of the European Commission are the key of the activity of the Italian EDCs Network
